20 Resolution for the appointment of the COMELEC Commissioner for the Gokongwei
21 College of Engineering for School Year 2016-2017.

23 Whereas, The USG shall have the power of which emanates from the student body. It
24 shall be the sole, unified, autonomous and democratic representative body of
25 the students (University Student Government Constitution Article III, Section
26 1);
27

28 Whereas, the Legislative Assembly is the highest policy-making body of the University
29 Student Government (University Student Government Constitution Article XIV,
30 Section 1);
31

32 Whereas, the Rules & Policies Committee shall initiate the review of the rules, policies,
33 and procedures of the Legislative Assembly, De La Salle University Student
34 Government, and De La Salle University, in coordination with the concerned
35 offices and/or units, and present recommendations to the Legislative Assembly,
36 De La Salle University Student Government Executive Committee and offices
37 concerned (LA Rules of Internal Governance Article VII, Section 3.1);

39 Whereas, there shall be an independent Commission on Elections (COMELEC) which
40 shall decide on all electoral exercises within the university (De La Salle
41 University Student Government Constitution, Article XIX, Section 13);

43 Whereas, the COMELEC shall be composed of two commissioners from each college
44 of the University (De La Salle University Student Government Constitution,
45 Article XIX, Section 14);

46

47 Whereas, the applicant for COE COMELEC commissioner Nel Jester S. Aguilar has
48 sent his resume to COMELEC (Appendix A);

49

50 Whereas, Nel Aguilar has never been placed under any academic or disciplinary
51 probation, has never been a member of any political party, and does not
52 currently hold any other Executive Board positions in any recognized student
53 organizations in the university, and therefore meets the qualifications of a
54 COMELEC commissioner (Election Code, Article IV, Section 3);

55

56 Wherefore, be it resolved that Nel Aguilar be appointed as the new COMELEC
57 Commissioner for the College of Engineering.
