**RESOLUTION CALLING FOR THE APPROVAL OF THE APPOINTED
MAGISTRATE OF THE UNIVERSITY STUDENT GOVERNMENT**

A resolution calling for the approval of Emmanuel Espina as an appointed magistrate of the University Student Government.

Whereas, the Legislative Assembly is the highest policy-making body of the University Student Government (University Student Government Constitution, Article XIV, Section 1);

Whereas, the USG shall have the power of which emanates from the student body. It shall be the sole, unified, autonomous and democratic representative body of the students (University Student Government Constitution, Article III, Section 1);

Whereas, the LA Representatives shall pass resolutions that are of relevance to the studentry (De La Salle University Student Government Constitution, Article XIV, Section 5.8);

Whereas, the Rules & Policies Committee shall initiate the review of the rules, policies, and procedures of the Legislative Assembly, De La Salle University Student Government, and De La Salle University, in coordination with the concerned offices and/or units, and present recommendations to the Legislative Assembly, De La Salle University Student Government Executive Committee and offices concerned (Legislative Assembly Manual, Section 4.1);

Whereas, the Magistrates shall be duly appointed by a group of representatives from both the outgoing members of the EXECOM and the Judiciary. (De La Salle University Student Government Constitution, Article XVIII, Section 5);

Whereas, the LA shall prescribe the qualifications of the Magistrates, Auditor, Investigating Officers and Prosecution Officers. (De La Salle University Student Government Constitution, Article XIV, Section 4);

Whereas, the applicant for magistrate has taken the magistrate exam (Appendix A);

Whereas, for colleges with vacant magistrate positions, the respective College Presidents will be responsible for the finding of applicants and undergoing the same process of interview and appointment;

Wherefore, be it further resolved that Emmanuel Espina be appointed as magistrate for AY 2016-2017;

Wherefore, be it finally resolved that this resolution be approved by the Legislative Assembly.
